PROGRAM

First Day - Arrival to selected accommodation unit. Meeting with leaders of the groups. Dinner. Optional night out in Prague. **Overnight.**

Second Day - Breakfast. Press-conference. Optional sightseeing tour of Prague (Old Town, Charles Bridge, Paris street, Staromestské Square, Orloj, Town Hall, J. Hus monument, Kafka's Museum, Prague towers, Obecni dum, Charles University, Wenceslas Square. Upon crossing the Vltava we can see Cathedral of St. Vita, the old royal palace, Golden street, the Basilica of St. George...). Dinner. **Festival opening. Performances of the groups. End of festival.** Optional going in the club. **Overnight.**

Third Day - Breakfast. Optional going to the Karlovy Vary - a spa town approximately 130 km west of Prague. Return to Prague. Free time. Dinner. Optional boat trip in the afternoon. Optional going to the club. **Overnight.**

Fourth Day - Breakfast. Departure of the groups. **End of service.**

GENERAL CONDITIONS OF THE FESTIVAL:

- The number of participants and followers is not limited.
 - There is no age limit.
 - It is necessary to prepare minimum one program - max 10 minutes per program.
 - It is needed to bring country's flag and a performance at the venue.
 - It is also necessary to visibly display panel (provided by organizers) which is inscribed with the name of your group and the name of your country.
 - Every group needs to send us 5-6 photos and some 'You tube' video from your group.
 - Participants can perform with orchestra (recommended) or with CD track.
 - Organizer keeps right to change some of the general conditions.
 - Organizer will inform participants about all possible changes in general conditions within 24 hours.
 - Organizer keeps right to cancel the festival at least 5 days before beginning.
 - Organizer keeps right to change hotel (and replace it with another at the same or higher category).
 - In order to participate in Festival, every group needs to fill in an application form.
 - After receiving application form, Organizer will send an official letter of invitation for participation at the Festival.

ABOUT PRAGUE

Prague is the capital and largest city of the Czech Republic. It is the 14th largest city in the European Union. It is also the historical capital of Bohemia. Situated in the north-west of the country on the Vltava River, the city is home to about 1.26 million people, while its larger urban zone is estimated to have a population of nearly 2 million. The city has a temperate climate, with warm summers and chilly winters.

Prague has been a political, cultural, and economic centre of central Europe with waxing and waning fortunes during its 1,100-year existence. Founded during the Romanesque and flourishing by the Gothic, Renaissance and Baroque eras, Prague was not only the capital of the Czech state, but also



the seat of two Holy Roman Emperors and thus also the capital of the Holy Roman Empire It was an important city to the Habsburg Monarchy and its Austro-Hungarian Empire and after World War I became the capital of Czechoslovakia. The city played major roles in the Bohemian and Protestant Reformation, the Thirty Years' War, and in 20th-century history, during both World Wars and the post-war Communist era.

Prague is home to a number of famous cultural attractions, many of which survived the violence and destruction of 20th-century Europe. Main attractions include the Prague Castle, the Charles Bridge, Old Town Square with the Prague astronomical clock, the Jewish Quarter, Petřín hill and Vyšehrad. Since 1992, the extensive historic centre of Prague has been included in the UNESCO list of World Heritage Sites.

The city boasts more than ten major museums, along with numerous theatres, galleries, cinemas, and other historical exhibits. An extensive modern public transportation system connects the city.

Its rich history makes it a popular tourist destination, and the city receives more than 6.4 million international visitors annually
